### Water Out in Canton Saves Local County Club

Steve Toohey of Mr. Rapid/ Water Out in Canton, Ohio reports on a job they did at local country club. Steve reports: "After a long spell of dry, springtime weather, mother nature dumped bucket loads of water to the tune of about 4 inches in a single hour. Mr. Rapid / Water Out in Canton, Ohio was called out to a local country club after water poured in under the doors and soaked brand new and very expensive (\$80,000.00) wool carpet that was just replaced after a pipe break this past winter. Knowing that wool carpet can shrink, brown, and otherwise smell like wet dogs, Mr. Rapid spent a good deal of time extracting water and mud from both carpet and felt padding. We did not want to even consider removing the carpet from the tack strip due to possible shrinkage, so with the aid of 30 Force 9 air movers and 1 Water Out trailer, we reduced humidity from an initial 85% to 15 % within 3 days and dried the carpet and pad in place. After a proper cleaning, the formal dining room was returned to its original condition...dry, clean and smelling good!

The room also included imported hand painted wallpaper that would begin to peel with the 85 % humidity levels. Again, with the speed of response time and the fast drying action of Water Out® the wallpaper was unaffected. Needless to say, the country club was extremely happy with the results."

Franks report: "We were contacted on a late Sunday afternoon about a loss that was caused by a supply line to a toilet on main level of the residence. The supply line broke flooding the structure for at least 2 days while the occupants were out of town. Within an hour and a half of receiving the call we were at the jobsite extracting over an inch of water from their fully finished basement. We set up a Water Out trailer to dry the fully furnished 1800 sq ft basement; where the ceiling, walls, furniture and carpet were literally soaked. Our Water Out Portable was set up on the main level which was also very wet. Four days later the entire structure was completely dry. The Water Out system saved all the walls, ceiling and floors.
