Water Out responds to Hurricane Ike

Hurricane Ike stormed ashore in Galveston, Texas last week and flattened the landscape. As far north as Houston homeowners and businesses were devastated and power was knocked out for millions of customers. Water Out crews from California and all the way to the east coast mobilized to help with the enormous after effects of Hurricane Ike. Action Restoration located on the bulls eye of the storm in Beaumont, Texas ignored the damage to their own property and the homes of their employees and got right to work. Water Out Texas/Action Restoration and their 28 Water Out trailers have been going non-stop since the flooding in Cedar Rapids, Iowa and Hurricane Gustav in Louisiana. Hurricane Ike was too much for the Action crews to handle on their own so they called in their Water Out partners. Water Out Coastal sent trailers, crews and generators to back up the efforts of Action Restoration.

Midwest flooding

Hurricane Ike, apparently not satisfied with the damage around the Texas coast, combined with another rain soaker and dumped over a foot of rain in the Midwest. Entire towns in Indiana, Illinois and Michigan are flooded. Water Out received hundreds of calls for help. Steve Harris, our Water Out partner in Michigan, has been sharing the work and problems with our other Water Out companies throughout the Midwest.

Here's a little newscast from Water Out Vancouver/ Canstar Restoration

Approximately 7000 square feet of warehouse including businesses on the lower level were all heavily affected when a hot water tank on the upper level failed. The team responded at 3pm on a Wednesday and continued extracting until 1:00AM Thursday morning utilizing 4 truck mounts. Two Water Out trailer were used to dry this massive space. The drying equipment had to be shut down during business hours and only ran from 4pm-8am each day. Even with drying interruptions this massive space was dried in four days.
