### Water Out teams up to dry salon in University Place, WA

Wally Stoneberg of Water Out South Puget Sound in Tacoma, WA sent in a report on a job they did with Water Out of Portland, Oregon in University Place, WA. Wally reports: "In early January we were very busy and every piece of Water Out® equipment we had was working fulltime on jobs from Aberdeen to Elum. Annie, who cuts my hair at Brassfield Salon in University Place, WA, told me to call the owner of the salon about a water loss. With steady rain for over a week the small creek behind the salon overflowed its banks and left 2 inches of standing water in their daylight basement.

Part of the basement is used as office space and the other part is rented to a fitness company. All of the carpet and padding was soaked and water had wicked up the sheet rock wall about two feet in over 90% of the basement. Since all my equipment was out on other jobs, I called Felix from Water Out in Portland, Oregon to see if they could help. Felix and his crew arrived early Saturday morning with his recently purchased Water Out trailers.

We set up the two units, one on each end of the daylight basement, on Saturday morning. By the start of business Tuesday morning both the salon office and fitness center were back to normal. The entire basement was completely dry. Dan, the owner of Brassfield's Salon, had worked in his early days hanging sheet rock for a living and was completely amazed with not only the dryness of the sheetrock but the clean smell of the basement.

My thanks goes out to Felix of Water Out in Portland, Oregon and his crew for their equipment and help."

### Mr. Rapid/Water Out of Canton, Ohio dries vacant office building

Mr. Rapid / Water Out of Canton, Ohio received a call from a local dentist who's vacant office building had a copper water supply line burst in the ceiling and sent thousands of gallons of water throughout the 2000 square ft. facility. After extracting several inches of water from the glue down carpet and removal of the vinyl cove base, Mr. Rapid utilized both of their Water Out trailers and quickly dried the structure in two days, saving the drywall and the carpet.
