### Rainbow International of the Quad Cities/Water Out in Davenport, IA sent in some losses they did over the winter

It is always great to hear from Water Out® licensee #1. We met up with Kevin Beirne from Davenport, Iowa during the floods in 2001 along the Mississippi River. Water Out® had not yet started to sell trailers and our entire fleet of trailers was dedicated to that flood. Our entire fleet consisted of one trailer. Kevin was so impressed with what he saw that he bought a trailer and became Water Out licensee #1. Both companies have come a long way since that time. Kevin and his company have had a busy winter and here are two recent projects they reported on.

During a recent cold snap a plumber called to help him save the home of his customer. The hot water boiler failed and all of the pipes were frozen. Fortunately, there was little water damage but the repairs could not begin until the home was warmed and the water pipes defrosted. A Water Out® trailer was set up and within two days the home was a toasty 80 degrees, the pipes defrosted, the plumbing repaired and the water damage areas were completely dry. We want to thank Kevin and his family because like all most of the Water Out members they are a true family business. It has been fun growing along with the Beirne family.

Rainbow International of Quad Cities reports on a second loss. A frozen pipe in a sprinkler head of a fire suppression system burst flooding 1100 square foot of a condominium. The water flowed from the third floor corridor down to the first level soaking three units along the way. Without removing any carpet or drywall the technicians from Water Out Quad cities and their Water Out® trailer restored the entire building in three days. *Great job!*

### Metropolitan Restoration Services/Water Out in Libertyville, IL dry out condo complex in 5 days

Another condo story and from one of our favorite newsletter contributors, Will Hughes of Metropolitan Restoration Services sent in pictures on a Water loss they did for a condo complex over the winter. The loss was due to a sprinkler pipe that broke on the third floor of the condo complex. Water traveled all the way down to the basement leaving 27 units affected and a large amount of common areas. Two Water Out Trailer were setup and 5 days later the entire structure was dry.
